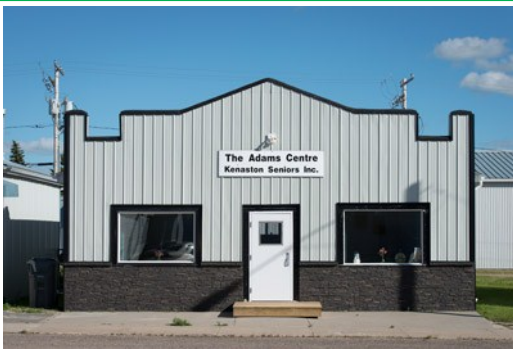
We have had many nice comments from the community on the new exterior of the Adams Centre. It is still a work in progress with some finishing to do yet. We are proud of our "New Look".

At the present time there is a need for additional daytime members to maintain sufficient firefighting capabilities. We can use both male and female fire fighters. In addition to fire fighting operation, the department also serves as the landing team for the STARS Air Ambulance and as a rescue team at motor vehicle collisions within the district. The level of involvement as a volunteer is up to each fire department member. Some members choose to respond only to fires and others respond to fires as well as rescue incidents. The Riverbend Co-op recently purchased the 4C's Corner Store from Les and Sonia Howells.

The Co-op is set to take possession August 1st. The plan is to move the Lottery, Liquor and convenience business into the existing Co-op building. Staff are currently re-merchandising to allow these services the proper space allocation. Some study will need to take place by Board and Management in regards to the best use for the 4C's building in the community in the next few months. Hours of operation will also be reviewed. However, sales dictate the hours of operation, and the Co-op is committed to operating a profitable service for all members. The more sales increase, the greater need for operating hours. This purchase, we expect, will strengthen the Kenaston Branch financially and provide the community with a consistent product selection and service well into the future. Our thanks in advance for your patience during this time of change.



Garbage Disposal Village and RM:

It seems some residents are still unfamiliar with the disposal regulations in the Village. The Kenaston website (under the "Council tab") has a full list of do's and don'ts so all residents are asked to become familiar with these lists. The Blue Bin behind the Coop is for recyclable material and is available for use at no charge for Village Residents, but RM residents must pay an annual fee of \$25 for usage. The Red Loraas Bulk-Disposal Bins by the water treatment plant are charged at \$5.00 per use, or \$18.00 if you need to fill a bin. The Red Bin at the dump is \$10.00 per use or \$25.00 per truckload. Residents should bring their load to the Village office to be reviewed prior to receiving a key to the dump. These bins are for village taxpayers only. The Red Loraas Bins by the RM Facility are for RM taxpayers only. All other bins are privately rented and if you leave your garbage in or beside them then the renter or the Village incurs the cost for proper disposal. *Misuse cannot be tolerated and we ask for your cooperation.*
