Swearing in of Alderman Dean Blenkinsop

- Present Mayor M.L. Whittles, Aldermen – Dean Blenkinsop, Mike Menzies, Kevin Mills, Leon Tomlenovich, Administrator Carman Fowler
- Order Mayor, M.L. Whittles called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- 21/14 Tomlenovich: That the minutes of the regular meeting of council held on Tuesday, February 11, 2014 be approved as read. Carried.
- 22/14 Corres. a) Maximum Highest to Lowest Mill Rate Factor
- 23/14 Tomlenovich: That the correspondence having been presented be filed. Carried
- 24/14 Lot Whittles: That the Village of Kenaston allow a 7 month extension to build to the future owners of Lot 15, Block 10, Plan 101489968 with a transfer back form signed in the case that a development is not started. Carried.
- 25/14 Financial Menzies: That the financial Statement and Bank Reconciliation for the month ended February, 2014 be approved as presented. Carried.
- 26/14 Accounts Mills: That we ratify the accounts that were paid before this meeting by cheques numbered #9092 through #9113 listed on Appendix “A” totalling \$13,969.24 and that the submitted accounts listed in Appendix “A” totalling \$9,090.42 be approved for payment with cheques numbered #9114 through #9122. Carried.
- 27/14 Tax Enforcement Blenkinsop: That the Village of Kenaston council will not proceed with acquiring Lot 2, Block 11, Plan G201 as long as the owner continues to pay \$500.00 per month until the tax arrears are brought to current and further that if any payment is missed, it will be reviewed by council as to how to proceed. Carried.
- 28/14 Waste Management Menzies: That the Village of Kenaston increase the waste management fee for residents to \$15.00 per month as of April 1, 2014 due to the increase from Loraas Disposal. Carried.
- 29/14 Waste Management Tomlenovich: That the Village of Kenaston increase the rental fee for the 3 yard Loraas bin used for public residence rental annually according to the increase from Loraas Disposal. Carried.
- 30/14 In Camera Menzies: That the meeting go in camera for discussion. Carried.
- 31/14 Out Camera Mills: That the meeting go out of camera. Carried.
- 32/14 Menzies: That the council accepts the progress report from the owner of Lot 12, Block 8, Plan M2869 providing he acquires a building permit, provides plans and contacts the inspector. Carried.
- 33/14 School Mills: That the village of Kenaston allow the school to decide which street side will be the frontage of the building for their new addition being built. Carried.
- 34/14 Pound Keeper Menzies: That the village of Kenaston council appoint Carman Fowler as the PoundKeeper Officer for the Animal Bylaw. Carried.
- 35/14 EMO Bylaw Menzies: That the bylaw 1/14 being a bylaw to amend the EMO Bylaw be introduced and read a first time. Carried.
- 36/13 Tomlenovich: That bylaw 1/14 be now read a second time. Carried.

37/13 Mills: That bylaw 1/14 be given three readings at this meeting. Carried.

38/13 Blenkinsop: That bylaw 1/14 be now read a third time and adopted.
