

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KENASTON HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 14, 2016 IN THE VILLAGE MUNICIPAL OFFICE AT 700 FOURTH STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF KENASTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN.

- Order Mayor, M.L. Whittles called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- 70/16 Blenkinsop: That the minutes of the regular meeting of council held on May 11, 2016 be approved as read. Carried.
- 71/16 Corres. Whittles: That the correspondence presented be filed. Carried.
- 72/16 Financial Blenkinsop: That the financial Statement and Bank Reconciliation for the month ended May, 2016 be approved as presented. Carried.
- 73/16 Accounts Whittles: That we ratify the accounts that were paid before this meeting by cheques numbered #10079 through #10107 listed on Appendix “A” totalling \$44,129.52 and that the submitted accounts listed in Appendix “A” totalling \$20,327.78 be approved for payment with cheques numbered #10108 through #10117. Carried.
- 74/16 Financial Statement Menzies: That the council approve the 2015 financial statement as presented. Carried.
- 75/16 Ball Diamond Tomlenovich: That the Village of Kenaston allow the Westman Family Reunion to use the village land where ball diamonds are located for their social gathering and camper trailers with any liability being the responsibility of the reunion group. Carried.
- 76/16 Dump Whittles: That the Village of Kenaston increase the dump wage to \$13.00/hour as per our policy manual retro active to start date of April 20, 2016. Carried.
- 77/16 Subdivision Blenkinsop: That the Village of Kenaston charge \$5,000.00 per acre or \$546.00 per lot for municipal reserve land value within the Village of Kenaston limits for all subdivisions and further that the Village will require the subdivision owner of NE ¼ Section 19-29-2-W3M, Proposed Parcel A to build the street required for access to this property according to Village speculation with the Village supplying the gravel. - 78/16 W & S Policy Tomlenovich: That the Village of Kenaston change the Village policy stating that the homeowner is responsible for the water and sewer lines from their dwelling to the water main and sewer main and further that any expenses caused from those lines are the responsibility of the homeowner.
