Village Council has analyzed all three options and has favored Option #4 for the reasons listed below.

(Option 1 is the present intersection).

Option #2

- Heavy traffic flows immediately behind our school and the new housing development.
- There will be lots of vehicular noise in town.
- The highway limits community development to the south.
- If southern development occurs the community will be spread on both sides of major highway creating dangerous crossings within the town.

Option #3

- Limits community growth.
- More risk for vehicular accidents as four avenues intersects with Highway 15 with blind spots due to the curvature.
- With highway 15 being rebuilt it is anticipated that traffic will triple which substantively will increase the traffic noise in town.

Option #4

- **Allows growth on both sides of our community.**
- **Creates room for commercial and residential growth.**
- **Creates a single 90 degree intersection onto the Highway 15 from Kenaston.**
- **Reduced highway noise for residents.**
