

SUMMER STUDENT FOR VILLAGE OF KENASTON

The Village of Kenaston is now looking to hire a summer student. The successful summer student would be working with Municipal staff at the campground, swimming pool, arena and municipal parks. Duties would include grass cutting, painting, maintenance etc.

Some office work may be required to help accommodate full time staff holidays.

If village maintenance staff feels the successful applicant is capable, the summer student may acquire a working knowledge of the municipal water treatment facility, learning how to do daily readings and chemical analysis as well as filter media backwash. The summer student may also learn how to operate various types of municipal equipment including, bi-directional loader and road grader. Reading household and business water meters will also be done by the summer student. Other reasonable duties may also be asked of the applicant.

As the student develops he/she will be offered more freedom to make decisions, but they will still be supervised and monitored for their safety.
