BYLAW NO. 12/91

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF KENASTON TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES WITHIN THE VILLLAGE OF KENASTON UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE SNOWMOBILE ACT, 1986 AS CONTANED IN SECTION 21(2)(B).

The Council of the Village of Kenaston, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. Notwithstanding the provision contained in subsection (1) of Section 21 of the Snowmobile Act, 1986, it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on any highway in the Village of Kenaston provided the snowmobile is duly licenced and the operation of the snowmobile is in compliance with both the Snowmobile Act, 1986 and The Highway Traffic Act.
- 2. This bylaw shall not apply to any provincial highway as defined in the Highway Act.
- This Bylaw shall come into force on the date of its approval by 3. the Highway Traffic Board.
